Sogreah's services

- ▶ Selection and implementation of pilot projects
- ▶ Development of action plans
- ▶ Public awareness measures



Context

The Donetsk Oblast (province) suffered from a highly polluted environment, resulting from its high level of industrialisation as well as insufficient treatment of solid domestic waste due, in particular, to the lack of available financial resources.

Description

The four main outputs of the project were:

- Local action plans in the municipalities
- Organisation of public information campaigns
- The Regional Strategic Plan for Solid Household Waste Management for the Oblast of Donetsk, 2005-2009
- The pilot project to set up selective collection in Kramatorsk and Slaviansk.

Aims

- To implement the strategy developed in the Tacis project "Improvement of Solid Domestic Waste Management in Donetsk Oblast of Ukraine" and to implement its recommendations.
- To develop separate collection and sorting of packaging in Slaviansk and Kramatorsk, which was initiated during the previous project.

Performance of the study

- Preparation of new waste and public service management schemes, developed and implemented at legal, administrative, regulatory and operational levels in municipalities and districts.
- Selection and implementation of the pilot projects for separate waste collection and recycling or for sorting and recycling.

- Development of action plans for similar initiatives developed and approved in other towns of the Oblast:
 - Replication of replicable guidelines;
 - Selection of towns ready for replication;
 - Specific adaptation of the guidelines to the selected municipalities.
- Implementation of public awareness activities to ensure active involvement of the public in the pilot project zone and increased awareness of waste management issues in general and of the pilot project in particular, throughout the Oblast.
