Context

This study is part of the project consisting in creating a public carpark and restoring the access roads around the medieval town, also including landscaping works.

Description

- Earthworks: 9,000 m³.
- Two-pass treated road surface: 4,000 m².

- Pavements, carparks and sandy paths (Sault Brenaz): 5,000 m².
- Wooden curbs: 1,200 lm.
- Rainfall runoff catchment: drainage swale.
- Installation of decorative lighting: 1,500 lm of cables, lighting columns, control cabinet.
- Installation of a watering system: 600 lm of pipes, sprinklers, disconnecter, etc.

- Street furniture: automatic barrier with a ticket machine, wooden benches, wooden footbridges, dustbins, landscaped stairs, oak crossbeams, etc.
- Landscaping: plants to make hedgerows, low hedges, saplings, grass, etc.
