### Description of Sogreah's assignment

The transport interchanges at La Garde and La Seyne are situated at the two ends of the first line of the Toulon right-of-way public transport network, currently being designed. They offer park-and-ride facilities with about 1000 parking spaces, and are essential for the right-of-way public transport network to operate correctly and attract users. Situated close to the railway stations, they act as multimodal transport interchanges (train / public transport / human-powered transport / cars).
